The Village of Fishkill Police Department now provides a Prescription Drug Disposal unit that allows the public to safely dispose of prescription and over the counter medications.

The Disposal Unit is located in the Police Headquarters Lobby (4 Wood Place)

THIS SERVICE IS AVAILABLE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

By participating in this program, Village residents will be making sure their unwanted pills and medication don't end up in a landfill or water supply. They will also be removing medication that could be abused, like pain-killers, from their homes.

Accepted Items Include:

Prescription and Over-The-Counter Medication. Medication samples, Veterinary Medications, & Liquid Medications.

ITEMS TO BE DISPOSED MUST BE IN A CONTAINER / ZIP LOCK BAG

Items NOT Accepted Include:

Syringes, Thermometers, IV bags, Bloody or Infectious Waste, Personal Care Products, Hydrogen Peroxide, Empty Containers and Inhalers.

NO HAZARDOUS MEDICAL WASTE or SHARPS ACCEPTED
